



# Cookie policy

- I. Using the website of **Jaworski i Partnerzy Kancelaria Radców Prawnych** may automatically result in collecting data about visitors to our website, such as: IP address, domain name, browser type, operating system type.
- II. These data can be collected by certain systems, i.e. Google Analytics, and used by cookie files (“cookies”).
- III. Cookies are used to improve the quality, search results and relevance of the displayed content, to create viewing statistics and to track the User’s preferences.
- IV. These data are processed exclusively by **Kancelaria Jaworski i Partnerzy**.
- V. Processing in the above manner is based on the prior consent granted by our Users, which is referred to in Article 6(1)(a) of the GDPR, and lasts until its withdrawal.
- VI. The cookies referred to in section 1 are files sent to the User’s device while browsing the Website of **Kancelaria Jaworski i Partnerzy**.
- VII. Cookies remember the User’s preferences, which allows, for example, to:
  - improve the quality of services;





- improve the search results and relevance of the displayed content;
- create viewing statistics;
- track the User's preferences.

VIII. Cookies do not change the configuration of your device or software installed on your device.

IX. You may object to the use of cookies (by blocking cookies), which in the future will prevent the storage of cookies on your device.

X. A User who does not consent to the use of cookies (by blocking cookies) may at any time select the appropriate settings in the web browser used by them. The process of blocking cookies varies depending on the browser and device that you use.

XI. If you want to delete the existing cookies, you should select the appropriate settings in your web browser or delete cookies manually. The process of deleting cookies varies depending on the browser used.

XII. Kancelaria Jaworski i Partnerzy advises you that blocking or deleting cookies may cause difficulties in using the Website, and in some cases may prevent the use of some of its options.
